LEVEL OF TEACHER SUPPORT

(pg. 269) Guiding Readers and Writers Grades 3-6, Fountas & Pinnell, 2001)

FACILITATOR

- Leader
- Calling on students
- Ensuring that conversation stays on track and moves forward

PARTICIPANT

- Part of the group
- Enter discussion to about the same extent as the students
- Use your own comments to model effective group behavior/communicating ideas
- Redirect the group, remind the group, and make sure that all members have an equal chance to speak

OCCASIONAL GUIDE

- Enter discussion only occasionally for specific purposes
- Directed toward helping students expand ideas or keeping the group focused
- Sit outside the circle

ROTATING OBSERVER

- Move around the room working with students
- Stop by the group to observe occasionally
- Do not intervene (usually)
